In order for your practical Day Skipper sailing course to be effective, you are required to already possess a certain knowledge of the theory notions necessary when going at sea.

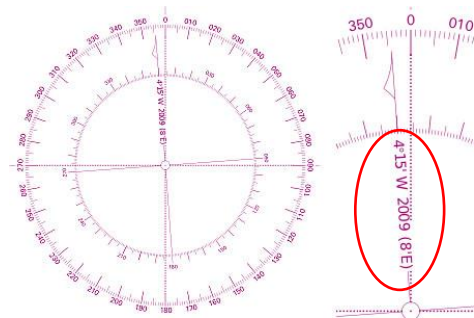

Please answer honestly, without looking up the answers in internet or books, as this will ultimately not help you to get to the level you want.

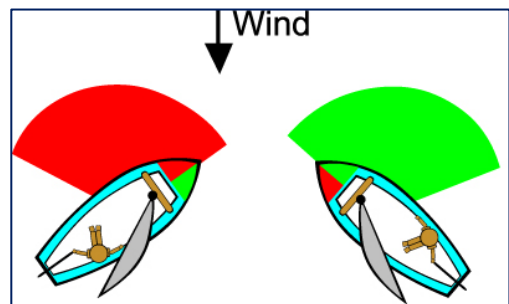

- 3) How do you use it?



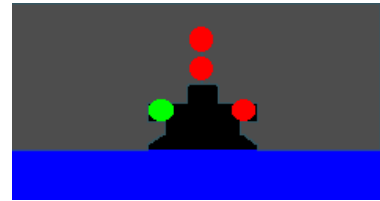
- 4) which one of the two sailboats is the Stand-on vessel (has the right of way)?

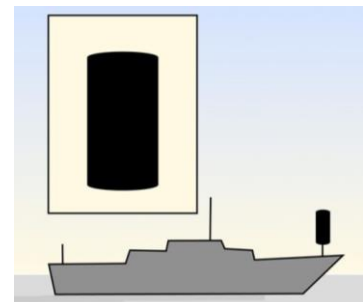
- 6) What is a vessel showing us these lights at night, telling us?



7) What about this vessel instead?



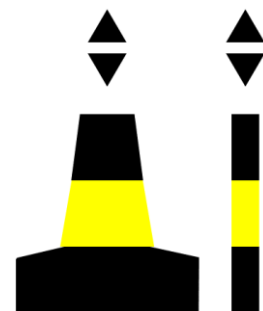
